

The registers, and the ring

The stock remedy register, withdrawal periods, movement permits and disease notification, kept with the production record. And, when a case is notified nearby, which of your sites falls inside the zone.

Compliance paperwork is usually assembled the week somebody is expected. The records exist, but they exist in a diary, a delivery note and a spreadsheet, so producing them is a reconstruction. Cluckiva keeps them where they are created, against the flock they belong to, which is what turns an audit into a report.

The dates that carry a deadline

Four things on a poultry site expire, and each of them expires quietly. Cluckiva counts them continuously and puts them on the first screen.

Withdrawal periods	Set by the treatment that started them, and held against the house the treated birds are in, so a withdrawal still running is visible to whoever is about to move or market that flock.
Vaccinations due	Scheduled against the flock and its age, so a programme is followed on the bird's calendar and not on somebody's memory.
Stock remedies expiring	Counted on the shelf, before the remedy is reached for rather than after it has been used.
Permits running out	Movement permits held with the register they relate to, so the compliance file and the movement file are one file.

The stock remedy register

Act 36 of 1947 requires a register of the stock remedies used on the farm. In Cluckiva it is not a separate book. A treatment is recorded once, against the flock that received it, and that single entry is what populates the register, sets the withdrawal period and raises the alert while the withdrawal is running. Mortality and culls are coded so that a notifiable case is already classified on the day it is recorded, which is the day the classification is worth having.

Editable only by permission. Every chart in the system is backed by the daily record behind it. That record is auditable and exportable, and it can be changed only by somebody whose role allows it. A register that anyone can quietly adjust is a register that proves nothing.

When a case is notified

The question after a notification is immediate and specific: which of my farms falls inside the zone, and how far is the nearest one. It is a question about distance, and a phone call is a poor instrument for answering it.

Cluckiva plots active outbreaks against your own sites and reports each farm by the zone it falls in: the infected zone within three kilometres, the surveillance zone within ten, and the awareness zone within twenty-five. Each farm carries its distance from the case, so movement decisions are made against a measured number.

Who did what, and when

Six permission roles run from read-only through to tenant owner, with an audit trail on every change. Multiple farms and multiple businesses stay cleanly separated, which matters when a contractor works across sites that are not owned by the same person.

Load shedding, recorded

An outage is logged with generator runtime, fuel drawn and service intervals against the equipment that ran. Two things follow from that. A dip in lay three days later has something to be read against, and the real cost of keeping ventilation running becomes a number that can be put in front of a bank.
